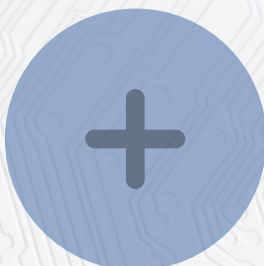

STUDY ON MARKET AND VALUE CHAIN SPECIFICITIES OF ESEE COUNTRIES

Our study on market and value chain specificities of ESEE countries aims to describe and analyze territorial Lithium-ion Battery (LIB) market value chain specificities. Findings indicate a rapid LIB industry growth accross the RIS region, due to the increasingly expanding EV market. Existing policies and regulatory schemes in the project participating countries could further improve to fully capture the capacity of the ReLi-ion technological solution.
